LOOKING AHEAD

There are quite a few projects and upgrades taking place to make sure our track is second to none and one of those projects will be undertaken by the NT Government.

This work will commence sometime in April and it will involve repairs to the track at the 330ft mark due to inconsistencies with the surface at the transition. An additional 20 metres of concrete will be added to both lanes and whilst this is not an ideal time for this to be happening, these repairs are necessary and will be welcomed by us all here at the Hidden Valley Drag Strip.
